

We have the pleasure to welcome you to the Global Forum "Skills for Work and Life Post-2015" that will take place on 14-17 October 2014 in the UN Campus, Platz der Vereinten Nationen 1, 53113 Bonn, Germany.

Important Note

Registration for the Global Forum will take place on Tuesday, 14th of October from 07:45 to 08:45 a.m. Please make sure to have a valid ID with you to pass the security control to be able to enter the UN Campus.

Plenary sessions will take place in two virtually connected conference rooms located on different floors. Seating arrangement on the first day is done alphabetically by country for the representatives of the UNEVOC centers and alphabetically by organization for other participants in line with the UN Protocol. Alphabetical order will be reversed for subsequent plenary sessions allowing the rotation of the participants between main and overflow conference rooms.

Düsseldorf Airport (DUS)

It is an international airport of the capital of the German state North Rhine-Westphalia, Düsseldorf. It is the third largest airport in Germany after Frankfurt and Munich airports.

Visitors arriving from Düsseldorf Airport can take the train from the airport railway station to travel to Bonn Hauptbahnhof.

Taxi from Düsseldorf Airport to downtown Bonn costs approximately € 150.

B. Arriving to Bonn

Airports

Cologne (Köln) Bonn Airport (CGN)

Cologne Bonn Airport is strategically located to cater for the 4th largest city of Germany, Cologne and the former capital of Germany, Bonn. It is one of the largest commercial airports of Germany and ranks 7th in terms of national passenger's statistics. The airport is closest to Bonn Central station (Hauptbahnhof) which is approximately 20 km away. You can reach Bonn Hauptbahnhof via bus or taxi.

From the airport, Bus SB 60 brings you to Bonn main railway station (Bonn Hauptbahnhof). The single fare is around € 7.50 (cash and credit card accepted). The ticket can be used for local transport to reach your hotel.

A taxi ride from Cologne/Bonn airport to downtown Bonn takes about 15 to 20 minutes and costs € 40.00 to € 50.00, subject to traffic conditions.

Frankfurt Airport (FRA)

It is a major transportation hub located conveniently near the main city centre of the 5th largest city in Germany and one of the world's leading financial centres, Frankfurt.

Visitors arriving from Frankfurt Airport can take the train from the airport railway station to travel to Bonn Hauptbahnhof.

Taxi from Düsseldorf Airport to downtown Bonn costs approximately € 250.

C. Getting from Bonn Hauptbahnhof to the Conference Venue (UN Campus)

By Bus 610, 611

At Bonn Hauptbahnhof bus station take bus 610 or 611 (direction Pappelweg) and get off at Deutsche Welle stop. You will find the UN Campus on your left.

By Metro 16, 63, 66

At Bonn Hauptbahnhof metro station indicated with the sign take lines 16 or 63 (direction Bad Godesberg Stadthalle) or line 66 (direction Ramersdorf or Bad Honnef) and get off at Heussallee/Museumsmeile. When leaving the metro go left, take the stairs on your left side to go up and proceed along Heussallee until you reach the entrance to the UN Campus.

Bank Services

An ATM (automated teller machine) from Deutsche Bank is located on the ground floor of the Langer Eugen, the UN Building with the UN logo on top.

Money can be exchanged at any bank.

The nearest bank to the UN Campus is the Sparda Bank, which is located along the Heussallee. To reach the bank exit the UN Campus and go straight following the left side of the street until Heussallee 12.

Opening hours of the Sparda Bank are: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday: 9:00-18:00 Wednesday, Friday: 09:00-13:00 Saturday, Sunday: Closed

Currency

The currency of Germany is Euro.

1 € equals 100 cent. There are notes for 5, 10, 20, 50, 100, 200, and 500 €. Please make sure to change your 200 and 500 € bills to smaller notes to avoid inconvenience when purchasing. Coins are available in denominations of 1 and 2 €, as well as of 1, 2, 5, 10, 20 and 50 cent.

Time Zone

Germany is in the Central European Time Zone (CET), which is 1 hour ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+1). Like most countries in Europe, Germany observes Spring Forward or Summer Time (Daylight-Saving), i.e. during the Summer months the time is shifted forward by 1 hour, resulting in GMT+2.

During the time of the Global Forum Daylight-Saving is still in full effect. It will end on 26 October this year.

Season and Weather

Bonn, alongside other places in Germany generally experience moderate climate. Specifically in the northwestern areas which include Bonn as well as the city of Cologne, the weather is characterized by relatively warm summers and mild cloudy winters.

Medical Services

Weather forecast in Bonn (12-18 October 2014)




